## Eligibility

- Head of household or spouse head of household must have Veteran status
- Must meet income eligibility criteria based on area median income for program area
- If household is residing in permanent housing, must have a valid lease, eviction or 3-day notice
- Currently literally homeless or recently exited permanent housing within previous 90 days and scheduled/desire to become a resident of permanent housing within 90 days
